



TOURIST PACKAGE 3 DAYS/2 NIGHTS




SPOLETO – CAMPELLO SUL CLITUNNO – CASTELRAIMONDO BORGO LANCIANO – FABRIANO

Day

1

Arrive in Spoleto city known worldwide for the scenic Piazza Duomo, one of the venues of the famous Festival of the Two Worlds and the imposing Rocca Albornoziana that, along with the Ponte delle Torri, can be considered among the most interesting monuments. Meeting with the guide and visit of the historic center. Lunch in a restaurant. In the afternoon transfer to the fortified village of Campello Sul Clitunno. The village is composed of two nuclei: Campello Alto, a fortified village developed around the Castle, and Campello Basso, where the church of the Madonna della Bianca is located. The real jewel of this territory is represented by the Clitunno Springs whose mirror of crystal clear water, fed by underground springs, is surrounded by a dense vegetation of weeping willows and poplars that give a charming and romantic atmosphere. Not far from the sources is the church of San Salvatore better known as the Temple of Clitunno, small shrine in the form of a temple of early Christian origins,







consisting of a cell preceded by a classic pronaos. In the evening transfer to Castelraimondo at the Resort Borgo Lanciano that stands on a sandstone slab that floats on one of the sources of the Potenza river. A feature that makes it unique in the genre and gives an indescribable feeling to those who have the sensitivity to grasp the essence. Dinner and overnight stay.

Day

Breakfast in the hotel and full day dedicated to relaxation and well-being within the structure divided into the two spaces of Borgo Antico and Borgo Benessere, over 600 square meters dedicated to wellness, the large outdoor pool surrounded by greenery, the heated indoor pool with hydromassage and counter-current swimming, the sauna, the Turkish bath and the area relax. Possibility of treatments and massages. Dinner and overnight.

Day

3

Breakfast at the hotel and transfer to Fabriano. Meeting with the guide and visit of the city with the Church of San Filippo, the loggia of San Francesco, the Oratory of Charity in which are preserved frescoes by Filippo Bellini depicting the seven works of Mercy, the Crypt of San Romualdo, the Church of S. Onofrio or Scala Santa, the Gentile Theatre, the main fountain called "Sturinalto", the Palazzo del Podestà the oldest Gothic civil building of the Marche region, the Cathedral. Lunch in restaurant with characteristic menu. End of services.
