The day concludes with hotel accommodation in the area.

DAY 2: MONASTERY OF FONTE AVELLANA - ACQUALAGNA

Day two begins with a visit to the Monastery of Fonte Avellana, a historic hermitage located on the slopes of Mount Catria. In the afternoon, you will travel to Acqualagna, which is famous for its white truffles, and have the opportunity to explore its market. You'll then return to your hotel for dinner and an overnight stay.

DAY 3: URBINO

The final day is dedicated to Urbino, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. You will take a walking tour to see major landmarks, including the Palazzo Ducale, the Church of San Domenico, and the Mausoleum of the Dukes. The tour concludes at the end of the day.

Day two begins with a visit to the Steam Train Museum in Fabriano. The highlight of the day is an unforgettable journey aboard a historic train on the Italcara Subappennina Railway from Fabriano to Pergola. The journey offers breathtaking views of the Marche Apennines.

Once in Pergola, the tour includes a visit to the Museum of the Gilded Bronzes of Cartoceto, home to the world's only surviving group of gilded Roman bronzes. You'll also explore the Cabernardi Sulfur Mines, providing a glimpse into the region's mining history. The trip concludes at the end of the day.

DAY 1: FERMO

Arrive in Fermo and visit the remarkable Roman Cisterns. Built in the 1st century AD, this complex of thirty rooms is a unique example of Roman engineering, designed to collect and distribute water throughout the city. Some sections were even in use until the 1980s. Afterward, check into your hotel for dinner and an overnight stay.

DAY 2: ANCONA - OSIMO

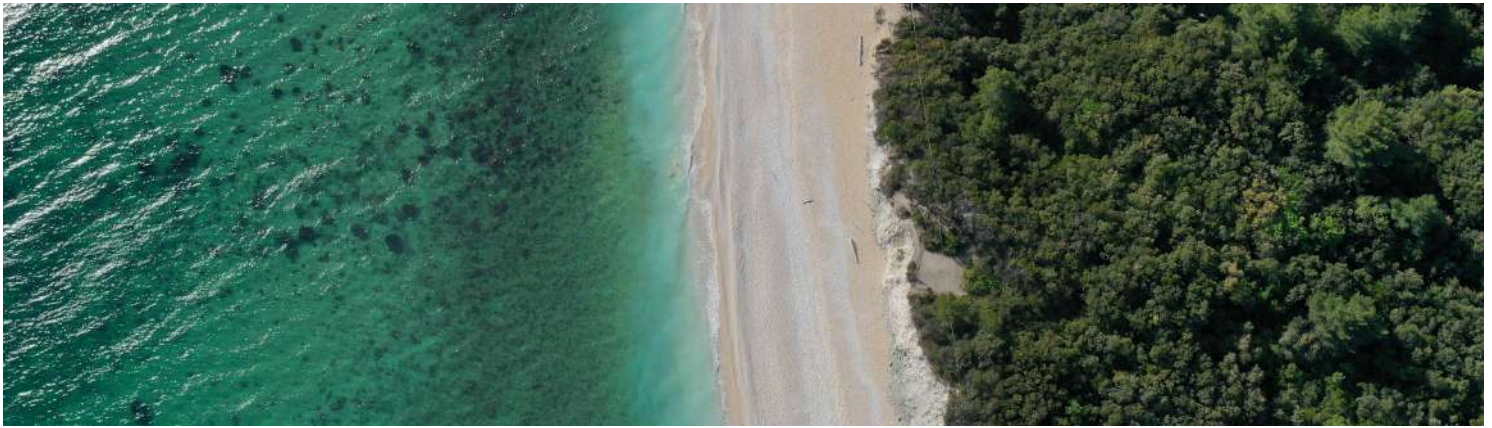
In Ancona, known as the "Doric city," you'll visit key landmarks. The tour also includes a unique exploration of Ancona's underground, specifically the Cisterns of the Fountain of Calamo, also known as the "Fountain of the Thirteen Cannelle." The journey then continues to Osimo, where you'll descend into its mysterious underground caves. The Caves of Cantinone are notable for their religious bas-reliefs, while the caves under Piazza Dante feature esoteric symbols. The day concludes with a visit to Osimo's main above-ground attractions.

DAY 3: PIAGGE - URBINO

On your final day, visit the Hypogeum of Piagge, an underground space with a cruciform layout. The geometric motifs and unique design suggest it was used for initiation or esoteric rites. The tour concludes in Urbino, a city renowned for its artistic heritage. Explore its historic center, including the birthplace of Raphael, Piazza della Repubblica, the Duomo, and the Ducal Palace, home to the works of the Galleria Nazionale delle Marche.

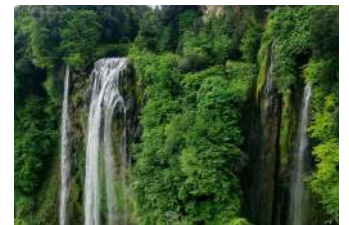

DAY 3: OSIMO - RECANATI - LORETO

This day is dedicated to three different cities. In Osimo, you'll explore the Cantinone Caves and other monuments like the Cathedral and the Civic Palace. Next, in Recanati, you'll visit the House and Library of Giacomo Leopardi. The itinerary concludes in Loreto with a visit to the famous Sanctuary of the Holy House and the Apostolic Palace.

DAY 4: MACERATA - ANCONA

The day concludes with a visit to the Museum of Trades on Bicycles, which exhibits vintage bicycles used for various trades and commercial activities.



DAY 2: FABRIANO

After breakfast, the group moves to Genga to explore the spectacular Frasassi Caves, an underground world of crystallized halls and lakes. Afterward, we will visit the Temple of Valadier, a place of deep spirituality located inside a cave, next to the Hermitage of Santa Maria Infra Saxa. The day ends with a visit to the Abbey of San Vittore alle Chiuse, a place of worship nestled in the green park. Dinner and overnight stay.



DAY 3: FABRIANO - CACCIANO

The trip concludes with a visit to the village of Cacciano, perched at 528 meters of altitude. The village is a true open-air art gallery, with the facades of the houses decorated with murals that tell stories of country life, nature, and wild animals. One of the most famous paintings is "La Vergara," a 7-meter-high mural depicting a historic resident of the village, Mrs. Italia. After the visit, the itinerary ends with lunch at a local restaurant.

DAY 1: SPELLO

The day begins with a visit to Spello, one of the "Most Beautiful Villages in Italy." Among its flowery alleys and ancient Roman walls, such as Porta Consolare and Porta Venere, you can admire the Church of Santa Maria Maggiore, which houses frescoes by Pinturicchio in the Baglioni Chapel. The itinerary continues to Rasiglia, known as the "little Venice of Umbria," where canals and water springs run through the alleys of the medieval village, creating a fairytale atmosphere.



DAY 2: SELLANO

After breakfast, the day is dedicated to Sellano, a medieval village rich in history. Despite the earthquakes, its castle still retains its structure. Must-sees include the Palazzo Comunale, with 16th-century frescoes. The main attraction is the Sellano Tibetan Bridge, one of the highest in Europe. With its 517.5 meters of length and 175 meters of height, it offers an adrenaline-filled experience to cross the Vigi river valley to the Castle of Montesanto. Once you've crossed, you can visit the castle and learn about its history, then return to Sellano by walking a panoramic path of about 2.5 km that leads to the charming Lake of Vigi.

Paper Route

The itinerary begins in Fabriano with a hike dedicated to the history of paper. You'll follow a path along the Giano river, an ancient Roman route that connected Umbria to the Marche region. Along the way, you can see the sites where, since the 13th century, there were fulling mills and paper mills that made Fabriano famous for its production. The hike continues to Camporege, an ancient medieval production hub. After lunch, the afternoon is dedicated to visiting the historic center of Fabriano and the Paper and Watermark Museum, where you can discover all the stages of handmade paper production.

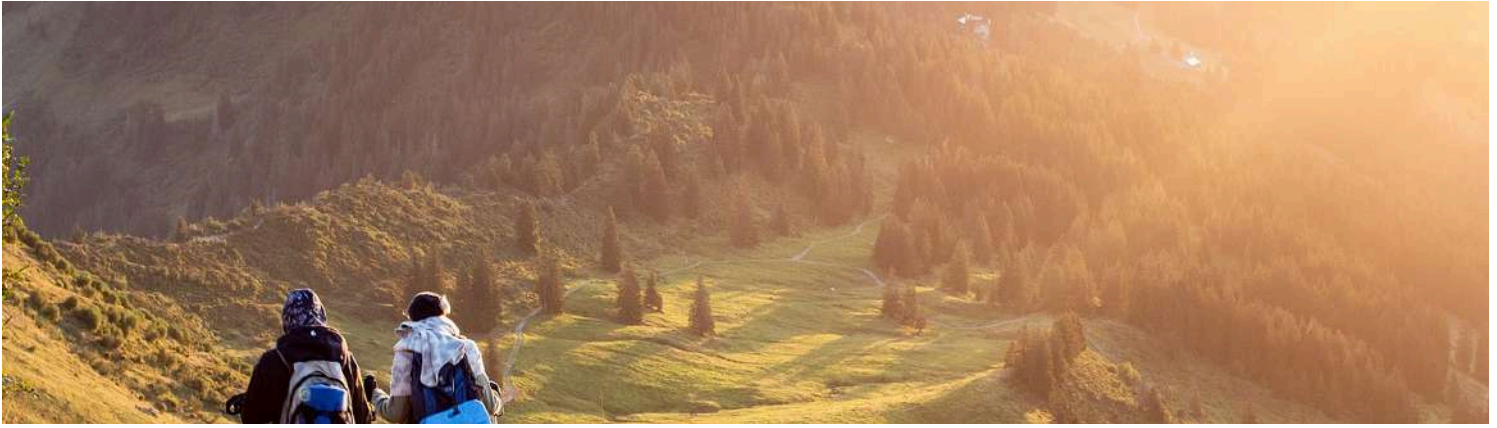

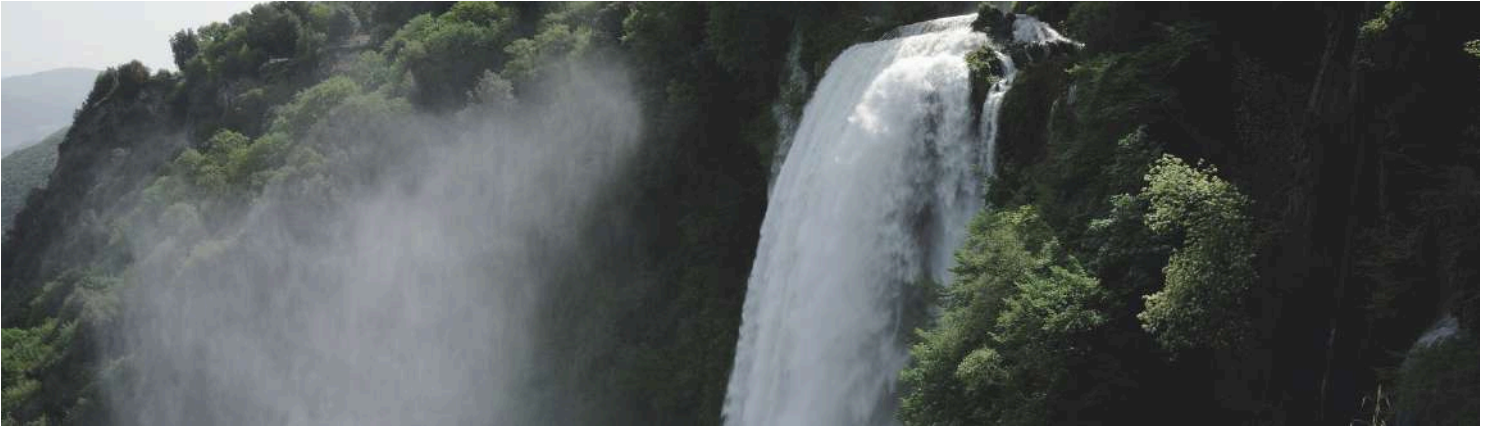

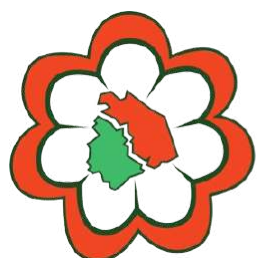
